We have storage for Supplies! <p>*We ask that PARENTS PROVIDE the above items to help maintain our inexpensive tuition cost. Having parents provide their child's items also allows PARENTS to CHOOSE what products/brands they would like us to use on their child.</p> <p>*Children are changed on an as needed basis, <u>BUT</u> in addition to regularly soiled diapers we follow the PA Department of Welfare guidelines and change children at a <u>MINIMUM</u> of every TWO HOURS if any wetness is present.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Must be FULLY potty trained with only OCCASIONAL accidents (Preschool Classrooms DO NOT have diaper changing facilities). Must be in regular underwear, but may continue to wear pull ups at naptime and during the first 3 weeks after moving to preschool classroom. Must be able to communicate need to potty. <p>*We ALWAYS transition children when it's BEST for the CHILD'S developmental needs. Children develop at different rates and we use a child's AGE as a GUIDELINE, not a ruling.</p> <p>*Prior to 9:00AM and after 4:00PM, the 1 Year Old children and 2 Year Old Children are grouped together in a "mixed group" to allow for additional social interaction and opportunity to gain new friendships.</p> <p>*Children "visit" the Preschool classroom they will be transitioning to for a few hours per day (for AT LEAST one week) before transitioning to the next classroom. This allows us to ensure readiness for transition and gives the child an opportunity to bond with new teachers.</p>
